US EPA EMISSION-RELATED WARRANTY

Alumacraft Boat Co. ("Alumacraft") warrants to the ultimate purchaser and each subsequent purchaser that this new Boat, including all parts of its evaporative emission control system meets two conditions:

- 1. It is designed, built, and equipped so it conforms at the time of sale to the ultimate purchaser with the requirements of 40 CFR 1045 and 40 CFR 1060.
- 2. It is free from defects in materials and workmanship that may keep it from meeting the requirements of 40 CFR 1045 and 40 CFR 1060.

Where a warrantable condition exists, Alumacraft will repair or replace, as it elects, any part or component with a defect in materials or workmanship that would increase evaporative emissions within the stated warranty period at no cost to the owner, including expenses related to diagnosing and repairing or replacing evaporative emission-related parts. All defective parts replaced under this warranty become the property of Alumacraft.

For all evaporative emission-related warranty claims, Alumacraft is limiting the diagnosis and repair of emission-related parts to the authorized Alumacraft dealers, unless for emergency repairs as required by item 2 of the following list.

As a certifying manufacturer, Alumacraft will not deny evaporative emission-related warranty claims based on any of the following:

- 3. Maintenance or other service Alumacraft or Alumacraft's authorized facilities performed.
- 4. Evaporative fuel system repair work that an operator performed to correct an unsafe, emergency condition attributable to Alumacraft as long as the operator tries to restore the fuel system to its proper configuration as soon as possible.
- 5. Any action or inaction by the operator unrelated to the warranty claim.
- 6. Maintenance that was performed more frequently than Alumacraft specifies
- 7. Anything that is Alumacraft's fault or responsibility.
- 8. The use of any fuel that is commonly available where the equipment operates and approved for use with marine engines and boats, unless Alumacraft written maintenance instructions state that this fuel would harm the equipment's emission control system and operators can readily find the proper fuel. See maintenance information section and fuel requirements of fueling section.

COMPONENTS COVERED

The evaporative emission-related warranty covers all components whose failure would increase the evaporative emissions, including those listed in 40 CFR part 1068, Appendix I, and those from any other system you develop to control emissions. The evaporative emission-related warranty does not cover components whose failure would not increase evaporative emissions.

The following parts are considered emission-related components for evaporative emissions:

- 1. Fuel Tank
- 2. Fuel Cap
- 3. Fuel Line
- 4. Fuel Line Fittings
- 5. Clamps*
- 6. Pressure Relief Valves*

- 7. Control Valves*
- 8. Control Solenoids*
- 9. Electronic Controls*
- 10. Purge Valves
- 11. Vapor Hoses

*As related to the evaporative emission control system.

Evaporative emission-related components also include any other part whose only purpose is to reduce evaporative emissions or whose failure will increase evaporative emissions without significantly degrading equipment performance.

LIMITED APPLICABILITY

ALUMACraft

As a certifying manufacturer, Alumacraft may deny emission-related warranty claims for failures that have been caused by the owner's or operator's improper maintenance or use, by accidents for which the manufacturer has no responsibility, or by acts of God. For example, an emission-related warranty claim need not be honored for failures that have been directly caused by the operator's abuse of the engine/equipment or the operator's use of the engine/equipment in a manner for which it was not designed and are not attributable to the manufacturer in any way. CALIFORNIA EVAPORATIVE EMISSIONS Control System Warranty Statement

YOUR WARRANTY RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS

The California Air Resources Board and Alumacraft Boat Co. ("Alumacraft") is pleased to explain the evaporative emissions control system's warranty on your model year 2024 Alumacraft boat. In California, new spark-ignited marine watercraft (SIMW) must be designed, built, and equipped to meet the State's stringent anti-smog standards. Alumacraft must warrant the evaporative emissions control system on your Alumacraft boat for the period listed below, provided there has been no abuse, neglect or improper maintenance of your SIMW. Your evaporative emissions control system may include parts such as:

canisters, carburetors, clamps, connectors, filters, fuel caps, fuel lines, fuel tanks, valves, vapor hoses, and other associated evaporative emissions control system components.

MANUFACTURER'S WARRANTY COVERAGE

This evaporative emissions control system is warranted for two years. If any evaporative emission-related part on your SIMW is defective, the part will be repaired or replaced by Alumacraft.

OWNER'S WARRANTY RESPONSIBILITIES

As the owner, you are responsible for performance of the required maintenance listed in your owner's manual. Alumacraft recommends that you retain all receipts covering maintenance on your boat, but Alumacraft cannot deny warranty solely for the lack of receipts. As the boat owner, you should however be aware that Alumacraft may deny you warranty coverage if your boat or a part has failed due to abuse, neglect, improper maintenance or unapproved modifications. You are responsible for presenting your boat to an Alumacraft authorized dealer as soon as the problem exists. The warranty repairs should be completed in a reasonable amount of time, not to exceed 30 calendar days. ALUMACRAFT LIMITED WARRANTY - USA AND CANADA: 2024 ALUMACRAFT BOAT

1. SCOPE

Alumacraft Boat Co. ("Alumacraft") warrants its model-year 2024 Alumacraft boats, excluding Jon boat models, sold by authorized Alumacraft Dealers from defects in material or workmanship for the period and under the conditions described below. This limited warranty will become null and void if: [1] the Alumacraft boat was used for racing or any other competitive activity, at any point, even by a previous owner; or [2] the Alumacraft boat has been altered or modified in such a way so as to adversely affect its operation, performance or durability, or has been altered or modified to change its intended use.

Non-factory installed parts and accessories are not covered under this limited warranty. Please refer to the applicable parts and accessories limited warranty text.

2. LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY

THIS WARRANTY IS EXPRESSLY GIVEN AND ACCEPTED IN LIEU OF ANY AND ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION ANY WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. TO THE EXTENT THAT THEY CANNOT BE DISCLAIMED, THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES ARE LIMITED IN DURATION TO THE LIFE OF THE EXPRESS WARRANTY. INCIDENTAL AND CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES ARE EXCLUDED FROM COVERAGE UNDER THIS WARRANTY. SOME STATES/PROVINCES DO NOT ALLOW FOR THE DISCLAIMERS, LIMITATIONS AND EXCLUSIONS IDENTIFIED ABOVE, AS A RESULT, THEY MAY NOT APPLY TO YOU. THIS WARRANTY GIVES YOU SPECIFIC RIGHTS, AND YOU MAY ALSO HAVE OTHER LEGAL RIGHTS WHICH MAY VARY FROM STATE TO STATE, PROVINCE TO PROVINCE OR COUNTRY.

Neither the distributor, any Alumacraft dealer nor any other person has been authorized to make any affirmation, representation or warranty regarding the product, other than those contained in this limited warranty, and if made, shall not be enforceable against Alumacraft. Alumacraft reserves the right to modify this limited warranty at any time, being understood that such modification will not alter the warranty conditions applicable to the products sold while this warranty is in effect.

3. EXCLUSIONS - ARE NOT WARRANTED

The following are not warranted under any circumstances:

- Normal wear and tear;
- · Routine maintenance items, adjustments;



- Parts and accessories not factory installed by Alumacraft Boat Co., such as, but not limited to : engines and controls, trolling motors, trailers, trailer tires. Such parts and accessories may have their own warranty policies. Please refer to the owner's manual or warranty policies provided by the respective parts and accessories manufacturer for the relevant part or accessory.
- Damage caused by failure to provide proper maintenance and/or storage, as described in the Operator's Guide;
- Damage resulting from removal or installation of parts (including engines), improper repairs, service, maintenance, modifications or use of parts not manufactured or approved by Alumacraft or resulting from repairs done by a person that is not an authorized servicing Alumacraft dealer;
- Damage caused by use of jack plates or power poles not installed or approved by Alumacraft prior to installation;
- Damage caused by abuse, abnormal use, neglect, or operation of the product in a manner inconsistent with the recommended operation described in the Operator's Guide;
- Damage resulting from accident, submersion, fire, theft, vandalism or any act of God;
- · Damages caused by improper loading and unloading procedures or trailering;
- Damage from rust, corrosion, corrosion due to chemical exposure, galvanic corrosion, electrolysis or pitting;
- · Damage caused by exposure to the elements, such as brackish or salt waters;
- · Damage or deterioration caused by improper storage, including in dealer inventory;
- Incidental or consequential damages, or damages of any kind including without limitation towing, storage, telephone, rental, taxi, inconvenience, insurance coverage, loan payments, loss of time, loss of income.

4. WARRANTY COVERAGE PERIOD

For private use owners, this limited warranty will be in effect from (1) the date of delivery to the first retail consumer, or (2) the date the product is first put into use, or (3) eighteen (18) months following delivery of the Alumacraft boat to an authorized Alumacraft dealer, whichever occurs first and for the applicable period below:

HULL

240 consecutive months for private use owners. This warranty is limited to riveted and welded hull seams.

PARTS AND COMPONENTS

48 consecutive months for private use owners.

PAINT AND COATINGS

36 consecutive months for private use owners. This warranty is limited to paints and coatings failures resulting from defects in materials or workmanship.

CONSOLES

36 consecutive months for private use owners.

CARPET AND UPHOLSTERY

24 consecutive months for private use owners.

For Boats produced by Alumacraft for sale in the State of California that are originally sold to a resident or subsequently warranty registered to a resident in the State of California, please also refer to the CALIFORNIA EVAPORATIVE EMISSIONS CONTROL SYSTEM WARRANTY STATEMENT contained herein.

For commercial use, the warranty period shall be 12 months. An Alumacraft boat is used commercially when it is used in connection with generating income, any work or employment or any professional services or activities during any part of the warranty period. An Alumacraft boat is also used commercially when, at any point during the warranty period, it has commercial tags or is licensed for commercial use. This is a minimal warranty period which can be extended by any applicable warranty promotional program, as the case may be.

The repair or replacement of parts or the performance of service under any applicable warranty does not extend the life of such warranty beyond its original expiration date.

5. CONDITIONS REQUIRED FOR WARRANTY COVERAGE

This limited warranty coverage is available only if each of the following conditions has been fulfilled:

- The Alumacraft boat must be purchased as new and unused by its first owner from a Alumacraft dealer authorized to distribute Alumacraft boat in the country in which the sale occurred;
- The Alumacraft boat must have undergone proper registration by an authorized Alumacraft dealer;
- The Alumacraft boat must be purchased in the country in which the purchaser resides; and
- Routine maintenance outlined in the Operator's Guide must be timely performed in order to maintain warranty coverage. Alumacraft reserves the right to make warranty coverage contingent upon proof of proper maintenance.

Alumacraft will not honor this limited warranty to any private use owner or commercial use owner if one of the preceding conditions has not been met. Alumacraft reserves the right to reasonably evaluate if the conditions are met. Such limitations are necessary in order to allow Alumacraft to preserve both the safety of its products, and also that of its consumers and the general public.

6. WHAT TO DO TO OBTAIN WARRANTY COVERAGE

The customer must cease using the Alumacraft boat upon the appearance of an anomaly. The customer must notify an authorized servicing Alumacraft dealer within three (3) days of the appearance of a defect, and provide it with reasonable access to the product and reasonable opportunity to repair it. Alumacraft is not responsible for



damages caused by the use of a boat after the appearance of a defect. The expenses of transporting the boat to and from an authorized dealer for warranty service are to be borne by the customer. The customer must also present to the authorized Alumacraft dealer, proof of purchase of the product and must sign the repair/work order prior to the start of the repair in order to validate the warranty repair. All parts replaced under this limited warranty become the property of Alumacraft.

7. WHAT ALUMACRAFT WILL DO

Alumacraft's obligations under this warranty are limited to, at its sole discretion, repairing parts found defective under normal use, maintenance and service, or replacing such parts with new genuine Alumacraft parts without charge for parts and labor, at any authorized Alumacraft dealer during the applicable warranty coverage period under the conditions described herein. No claim of breach of warranty shall be the cause for cancellation or rescission of the sale of the Alumacraft boat to the owner.

In the event that service is required outside of the country of original sale, the owner will bear responsibility for any additional charges due to local practices and conditions, such as, but not limited to freight, insurance, taxes, license fees, import duties, and any and all other financial charges, including those levied by governments, states, territories and their respective agencies.

Alumacraft reserves the right to improve or modify products from time to time without assuming any obligation to modify products previously manufactured.

8. TRANSFER

This limited warranty may be transferred from a first retail purchaser once to a second retail purchaser. In order to be transferred, the second retail purchaser must have the Alumacraft boat inspected by an authorized Alumacraft dealer within thirty (30) days of the transfer of ownership. The limited warranty transfer will be effective upon submission of a completed inspection form accompanied by pictures, proof that the former owner agreed to the transfer of ownership and the coordinates of the new owner.

9. CONSUMER ASSISTANCE

In the event of a controversy or a dispute in connection with this Alumacraft limited warranty, Alumacraft suggests that you try to resolve the issue at the dealership level. We recommend discussing the issue with the authorized Alumacraft dealer's service manager or owner.
